



“Dorchester Countians Felt the Effects of WWII”, by Carlton & Mary Nabb, Wednesday, 6 September 2017

Carlton Nabb has spent his 71 years in Dorchester County living and working within the farming community. He is a sixth generation farmer of North Yarmouth Farm situated a few miles southeast of Cambridge. Carlton attended school in Cambridge, graduating with the 1964 class of Cambridge High School.

Carlton and his wife Mary gave a presentation on Carlton's father, George B. Nabb Jr. who left the farm in 1941 to serve in the U.S. Army in the 29th Infantry Division in WWII. Just a few years ago they discovered the story of George Nabb in Europe during the war, written in letters that were sent home to his wife, Georgia Nabb. This incredible story covers a span of four years, from 1942 to 1945 when he returned to the States. The letters tell little of the war front, but instead reflect what was happening here in Dorchester County and how the war was affecting life here in our community. Many local friends, neighbors and fellow soldiers are mentioned.
