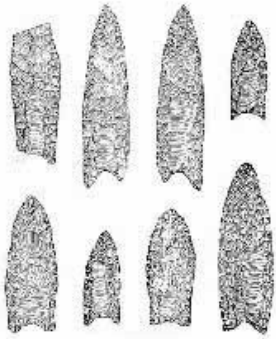




Native American Artifacts at Dorchester County Historical Society, Terry Crannell, 15 November 2004
