Saving our Past ~ The Old Hoopers Island Graveyard, by Jacqueline Hedberg, 7 February 2007

When the cemetery was not chosen as one of the thirteen treasures to receive state funding, Jacqueline Hedberg formed the Friends of the Graveyard to restore and maintain the site. Jacqueline Hedberg describes how the group was started and what they have done so far.

While working to restore a family home, Jacqueline Hedberg located a family cemetery of some 75 graves nearby. In 2000, the Old Hoopers Island Graveyard was one of 182 sites identified as "Endangered Maryland Treasures."
